How does it work and what do I need to provide?

- Register for our free portal at www.inheritancedata.co.uk which provides 24/7 access to third parties conducting the search as well as individuals
- Log into your account and select Power of Attorney Search
- Fill in our simple online submission form with details of the person whose assets need to be searched, including, DOB, NI number and addresses
- Upload a registered Lasting Power of Attorney, (LPA), Deputyship Order or Court of Protection Order and a Letter of Authority signed by the Attorney (Available to download in our portal)
- Submit the search
- You can log into your secure account on the online portal to check matches and no matches 24/7. Each report shows all the institutions that have responded, along with details to help with the claiming process. The online report is available from day one of the search and willl uncover a map of the estate's financial history
